VIENNA, VA, April 11, 2011 – The International Association for K-12 Online Learning (iNACOL) is hosting a webinar on “Mobile Learning: Integrating Mobile Technologies into Online Learning Environments” on Wednesday, April 13, 2011, from 2:00 - 3:00 PM (Eastern) via Elluminate.

According to Susan Patrick, President and CEO of iNACOL, “Mobile learning is a growing trend around the globe for expanding access to student educational opportunities. The webinar will highlight initiatives in the United States and allow the opportunity for presenters and attendees to discuss emerging models.”

Dr. Richard Hezel, a nationally recognized research expert, will facilitate a discussion with panelists representing three programs:

- Forsyth County Schools, Georgia – Jill Hobson and Tim Clark will discuss what they have learned during the initial implementation of the "Bring Your Own Technology" (BYOT) program. In this program, students are encouraged to bring devices such as iPods, laptops, cell phones, and gaming devices to school for accessing new models of instruction.
- Virtual Virginia – Scott Cloud and Tara Farr will discuss their students' experiences using iPads to access online AP[®] Biology courses.
- Catholic Schools K-12 Virtual – Trina Trimm will discuss the impact of affordable mobile devices and digital content to provide education in areas where students' primary access to the Internet is via their cell phones.
